

A Small Town Full of Charm

Voted Travel & Leisure's #3 small town in the U.S., Hotel Heron sits at heart of Old Town Alexandria offering guests to experience Old Town from a new vantage point.

With Washington, DC just minutes away, Hotel Heron acts as a flag in the sand just across the river, beckoning travelers to explore beyond the National Mall and Monuments to discover a city ripe for its new renaissance.

Originally opened in 1926 as the George Mason Hotel, this adaptive reuse combines the iconic inn with an adjacent new building that houses a modern event space and elevated guest rooms. This chic 134 room boutique hotel is home to KILN, a signature ground floor restaurant serving hearth inspired Mid-Atlantic cuisine, Francis Hall, a cozy craft cocktail bar hidden in the heart of the hotel, and Good Fortune, an openair seasonal rooftop bar with unparalleled views of the Potomac. Elevated amenities include a state-of-theart fitness center and meeting spaces designed for socializing, co-working, creating, eating, drinking, and relaxing. The hotel brings together world travelers and neighbors alike while showcasing Alexandria's rich legacy and knack for innovation through thoughtful touches from local businesses and artisans.
